We're looking forward to another amazing year! We hope to see all of our veteran singers back, along with some new faces. We'd love to have a few more young men to build our tenor section! Space is limited, so please turn in your permission slip (see page 2 – attached) as soon as possible.

The choir is open to students in 4th through 8th grades by audition. Sixth through 8th grade students can earn up to 20 service hours by participating at performances, including: parish masses, school masses, etc. Eighth grade students with three years of choir participation earn a service pin.

We will need the volunteer support of many parents throughout the school year in order to make this a great experience for the children. Parent volunteers can fulfill family service hour commitments by sharing their time with the choir. More information will be forthcoming with opportunities to help out very soon.

We will rehearse each Thursday (NOTE CHANGE!!!) from <u>7:45-8:25 a.m.</u> in the music room. Our rehearsal time is very limited, so please have your child at school ready to sing <u>no later than 7:45 a.m.</u>

We will be continuing CantorCore for those students who want to take their singing to the next level, be ready for more advanced High School choirs, and who enjoy the ministry side of music. This group will meet about twice a month and attendance is optional. Those students participating in CantorCore will be the goto students for cantoring, solos, and special events, and we'll spend more time developing their singing and musicianship skills. PLEASE CHECK the box on the attached permission slip if you are interested in CantorCore.

As stated in the School Handbook, choir members must maintain at least a "C" or better grade average and a "C" or better in conduct. Students must be on time to rehearsals and behave appropriately. If a student is habitually late, absent, or falls behind in their regular class work, the directors and classroom teacher will work together to evaluate whether the student can remain in the choir.

NEW AND RETURNING SINGERS need to return the attached permission slip to the school office no later than Monday, 9/16. Auditions for new students will start on Tuesday, 9/3 by arrangement with the home room teacher. Returning students do not need to audition unless they would like to switch to a different voice part (soprano to alto or vice versa).
